

On Tuesday 6/14/17 Microsoft came out with a security update that caused PTS to not print properly. Everyone was advised that the temporary fix was to uninstall the update that caused the issue, until Microsoft came out with a patch that fixed it. Microsoft came out with a repair for this issue around 7/6/17.

Now that Microsoft has fixed this, it is highly recommended to **FULLY UPDATE YOUR SYSTEM** to fix security risks. It is VERY IMPORTANT TO INSTALL ALL RECOMMENDED UPDATES.

Windows 7/8/8.1

1. Open Control panel
 - a. Press Windows Key + R on the keyboard to open a run dialog box
 - b. Type "control" with no quotations and press Enter
2. On the "All Control Panels Items", locate the "System" icon and click on it . See example below:

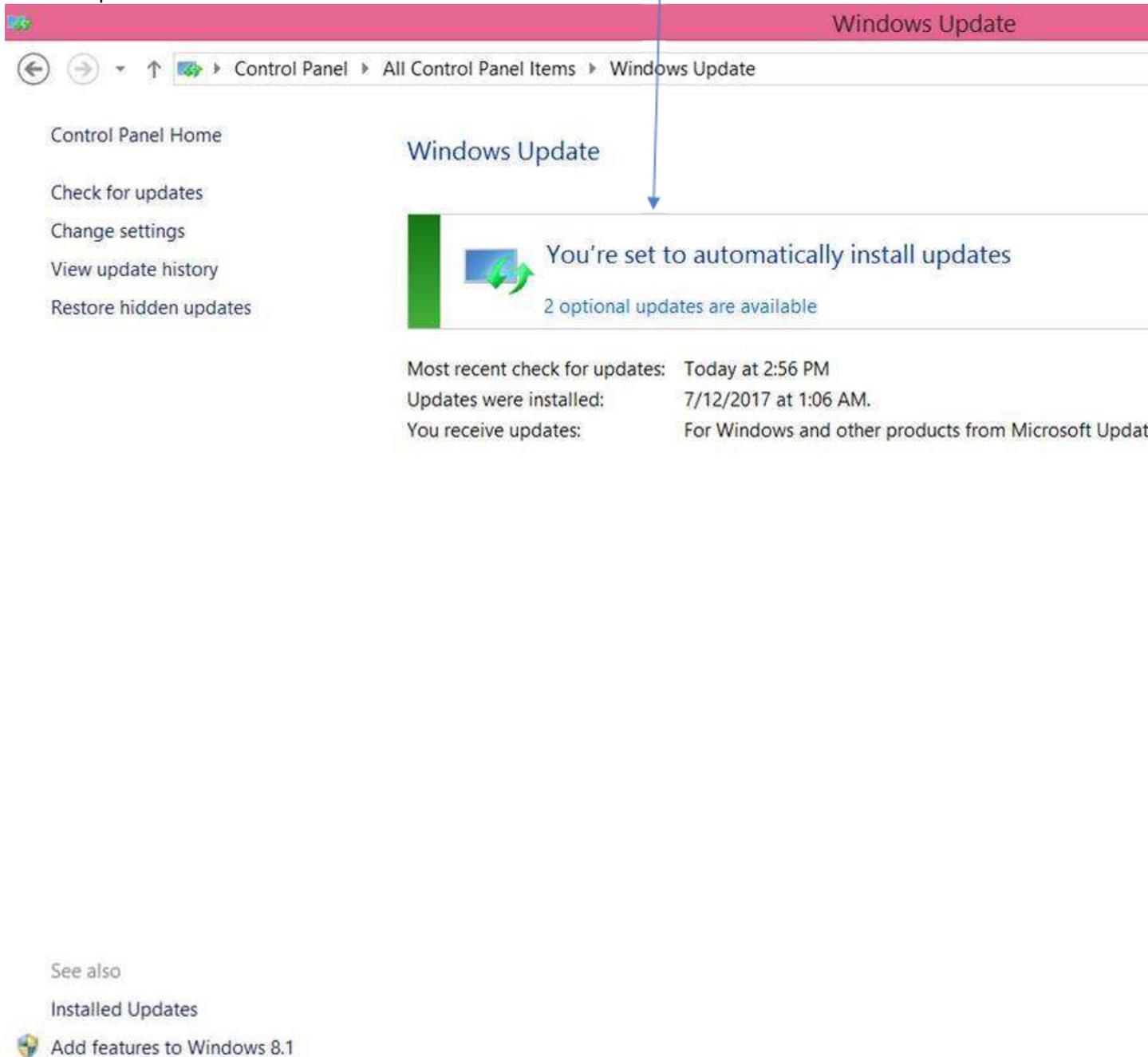

4. Once finished checking for updates, select all Important and Optional updates, then Install. A computer restart will be required.

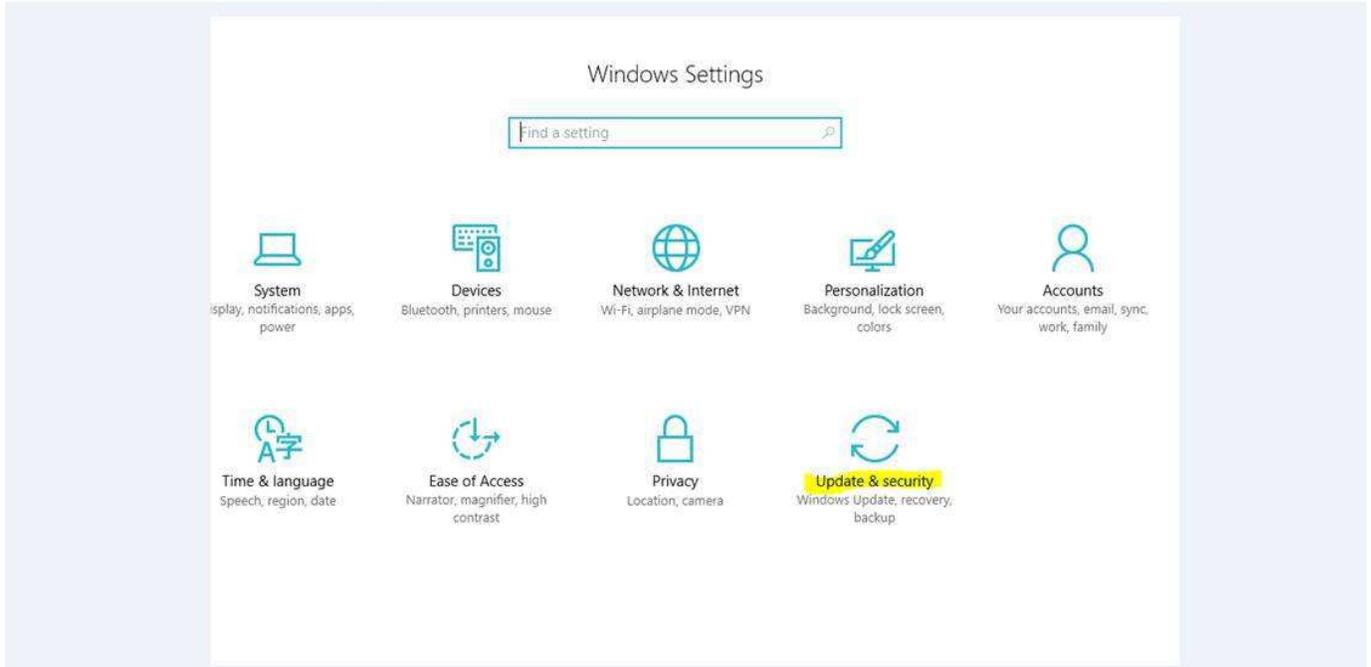


5. Once restarted, check for updates again and install any updates that populated. Repeat until no updates remain

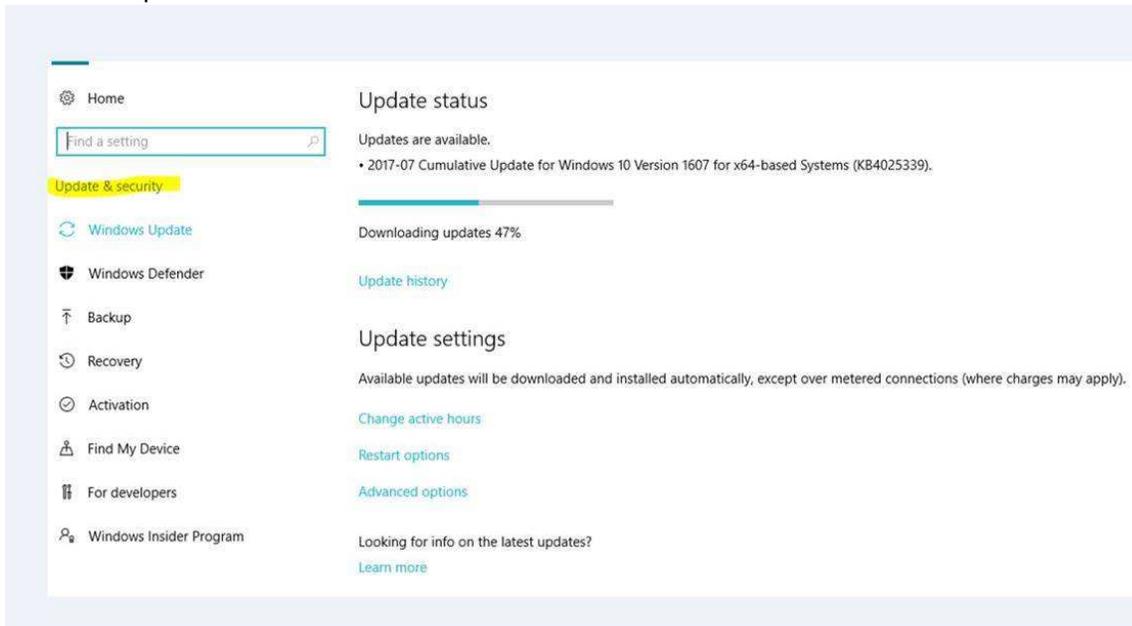
Window 10 instructions on next page....

Windows 10

1. Click the Start Menu, then Settings on the bottom left side
2. Navigate to Update and Security



3. Check for Updates



4. Windows 10 will automatically download and install all available updates.
5. Once prompted, restart computer
6. Once restarted, check for updates again and install any updates that populated. Repeat until no updates remain

The whole process will take between 30 minutes and 2 hours. You may need to have Administrator Privileges to install updates properly. If you do not have Administrator Privileges, contact your System Administrator to assist with completing these steps. You can use the computer while the updates are downloading and start preparing to install. It is recommended to do this early on in the day as this will take the longest. Once completed the computer restart may be done at a convenient time, however during a lunch break or upon leaving for the day will work best to prevent down time.
